Captain Walter Theriot was recognized and reports on the following for August 3 – August 17, 2022: Total callouts 138, medicals 7, total arrest 2, total summons 3, total citations 56, golf cart summons 0, court fines paid \$7,431.73, tags sold \$4,125.00

Joseph Chauvin with GIS Engineering was recognized and reports on the following:  
1.) **FEMA Updates** – 1.) 2020 Hurricane Zeta work in progress follow up meeting needs to be scheduled. 2021 Hurricane Ida work in progress. 2.) **Grand Isle and Vicinity Breakwaters** – CPRA UPDATE- Interim Dune Repairs will be awarded. Breakwaters, first section is complete, next repairs is awarded first qtr of 2023. Clay repairs will be awarded in 2<sup>nd</sup> qtr of 2023. 3.) **Mayor and Council Request** – Multiplex Bldg roof inspection of performed July 7, with contractor to view top to the roof. Gathering information on the repair or replacement.

Permit updates for drainage pumps: Landry's Hole and Cypress DNR authorization required the project start by May 7, 2022. Because of Hurricane Ida working on getting this justified on the work not starting on time. Orange Lane pump requires start by July 6, 2023 and Chighizola Lane pump requires start by March 9, 2024.

Carles Sponge, Town Supervisor was recognized and introduced.

Ronnie Sampey with GIGC was recognized and reports on the following: 1.) Live rings on post are being broken. Damaged trees (22) at the community ctr will be removed. Replace with new ones. 2.) Scott Fencing will place fence on Medical Lane property starting this week.

Weldon Danos with Grand Isle Port Commission was recognized and reports on the following: 1.) Federal Navigation Channel Dredging Project Update: Baratara Bar Channel commenced 8/10/22. Last dredged was in 2019. Duration between 8/10/22 thru 9/20/22, 24 hours/day-7 days/week. Disposal site is Grand Terre.

Motion by Council Member Brian Barthelemy seconded by Council Member Lan Tivet and unanimously agreed to open agenda.

The following proposed ordinance was introduced with hearing scheduled for the regular town meetings of September 14, 2022 and September 28, 2022 at which time it will be eligible for adoption.

Mayor request/report: 1.) Thanks to Council Member Brian Barthelemy for hard work during Hurricane Ida recovery. 2.) Town of Grand Isle cannot afford to purchase dwelling insurance. Looking at funding for fire & flood. 3.) September 15, 2022 hauling sand along hurricane protection levee and removing sand bags.
